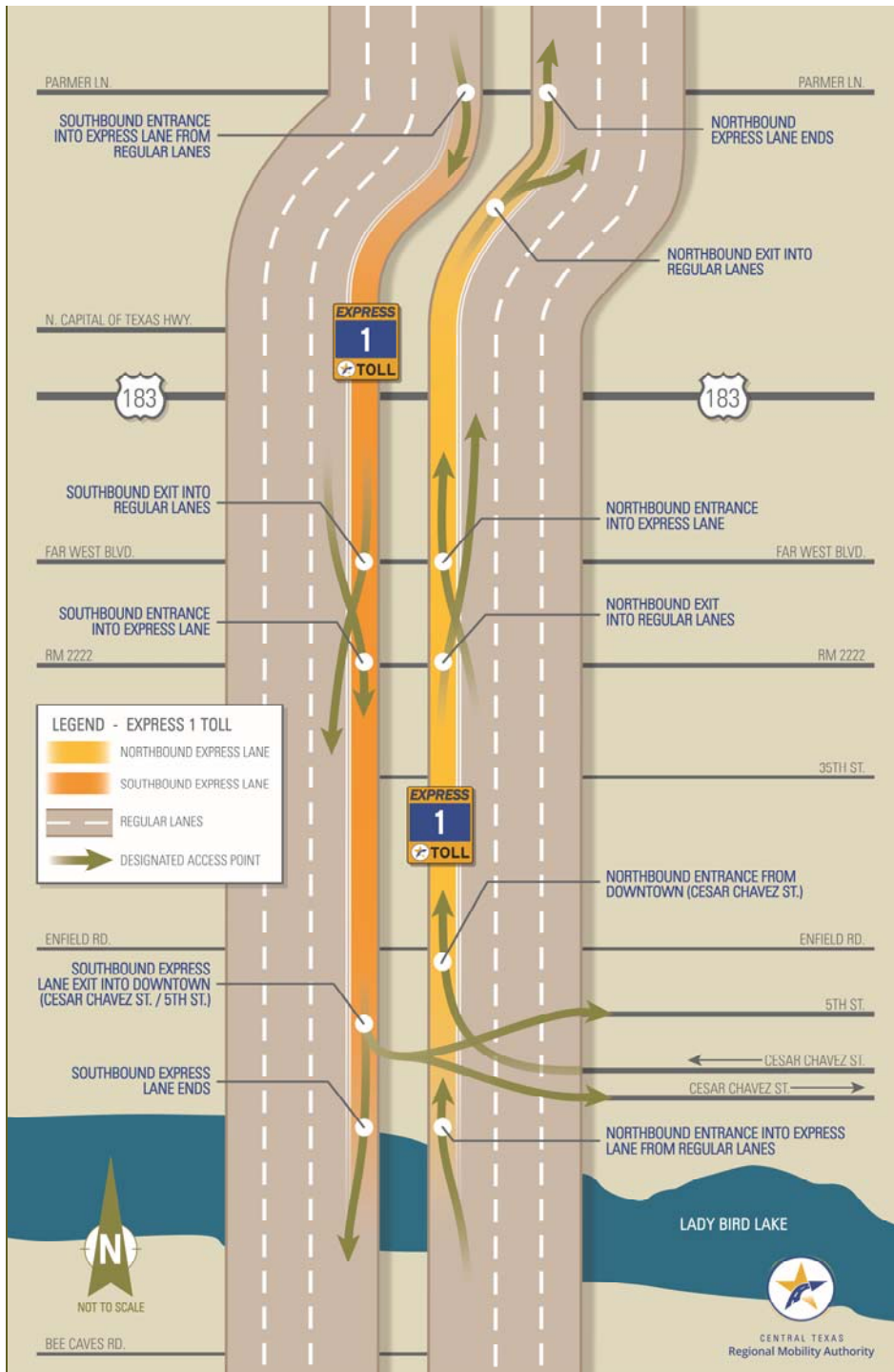
- A multi-modal transportation agency authorized under 2001 state legislation
- A regional agency formed in 2002 by Williamson and Travis Counties
- Authorized to pursue wide range of transportation projects (multi-modal)
- Toll revenue primary source of funding
- Oversight by a seven member board of business and community leaders
 - 23 employees

- SH 45, Loop 1, and SH 130 north (TxDOT)
- SH 130 South (SH 130 Concession Company)
- 183A Expressway (Mobility Authority)
 - Phase 1 Opened March 2007
 - Phase 2 Opened April 2012
- Manor Expressway (Mobility Authority)
 - Phase 1 Opened December 2012
 - Phase 2 Opened May 2014
 - MoPac Express Lanes (Under Construction)
 - 183 South Expressway (Under Construction)



MOPAC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

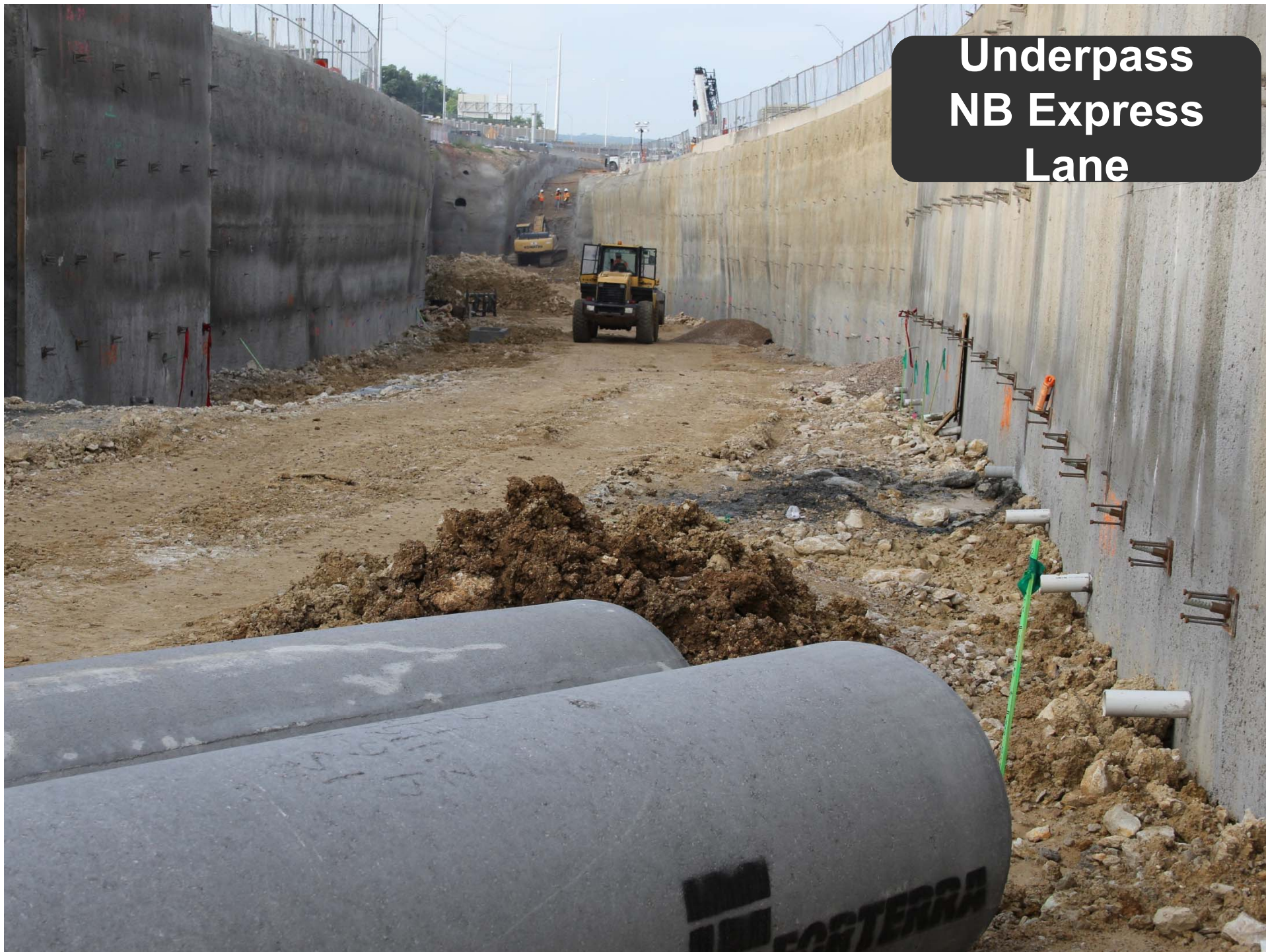
- One express lane in each direction from Cesar Chavez Street to Parmer Lane

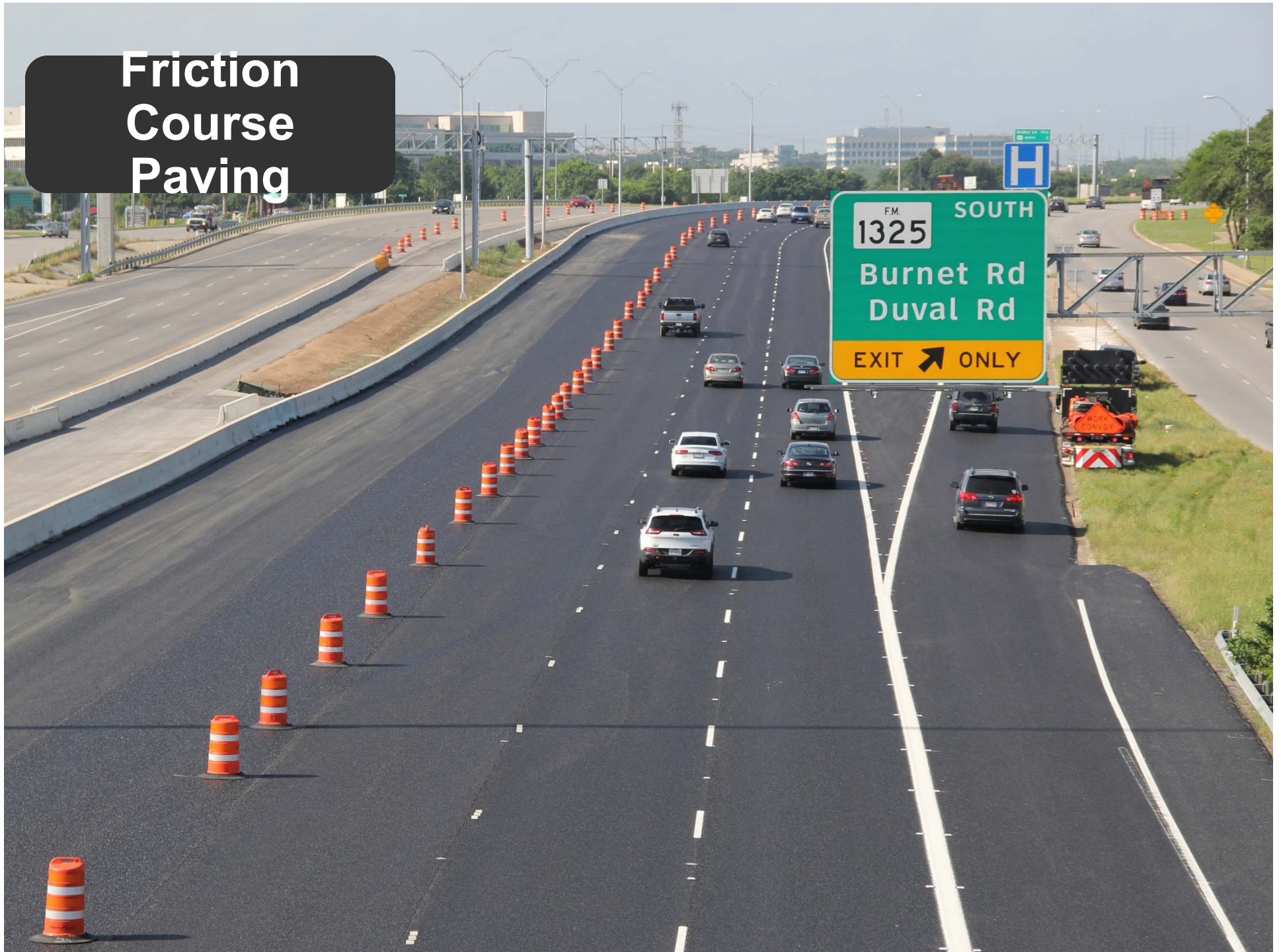

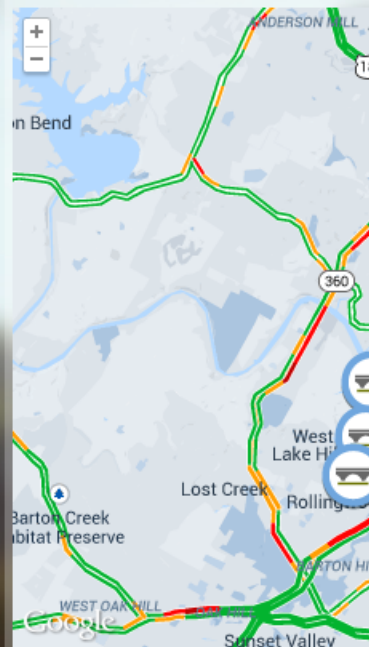

Upcoming Outreach Issues



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- Increased lanes closures, nighttime activity and noise
- Asphalt paving of entire corridor with emphasis on RM 2222 to Parmer Lane over next two months
- Construction of Sound Wall 8 along northbound MoPac between 35th Street and 45th Street
- Realignment of southbound MoPac at Cesar Chavez/5th Street exit in preparation for opening of southbound express lane
